

Early Birds

Early Birds is a program for PreK3 through 5th grade students. The Early Bird program is designed to provide a supervised, safe place for those children who need to arrive early at school. Students may arrive at 7:00 a.m. and are released into the regular school program as the day begins at 8:00 a.m. The cost for this program will be \$5 per student, per day and will include a light breakfast upon request. Students may have breakfast, read, complete and/or get additional homework help, or participate in light recreational activities during Early Birds.

Beyond the Bell

Beyond the Bell is an after-school program designed to meet each student's needs for afternoon activities and afford families the peace of mind knowing that their child(ren) is/are safe and having fun with his or her school friends in an enriching environment. Instruction about the essential life skills of charity, respect, and cooperation is continued as part of each student's day.

Beyond the Bell will be offered from the time each student is dismissed until 6:00 p.m. at a cost of \$4 per student, per hour (pre-registered) or \$6 per student, per hour (drop-in). Students will be provided with a daily, healthy snack, engaging activities, fun and creative experiences, and additional academic support. Families may pick up their child(ren) at any point between school dismissal and 6:00 p.m.
